This show is approved by the Alpaca and Llama Show Association, Inc. All rules and guidelines for this show will be in accordance with the Current Edition ALSA Handbook

•AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place in each class. Trophies and/or Prizes may be awarded to Grand and Reserve Champions in halter classes, Open Performance Champion and Youth Performance Champions. You must compete in three classes to quality (Youth must compete in Youth Obstacle, Youth Public Relations and Youth Pack. The same animal must be used in all classes.) Youth classes, Junior 8-11, Intermediate 12-14, Senior 15-18 may be combined if there are not 8 in a youth division.

Animals may only show in ONE Performance Division (animals showing in Youth Division may NOT show in Open Division). A llama may NOT be entered in any class more than once. Youth may compete in Open Performance and Youth Performance if using a different llama for each division. Youth may exhibit only ONE entry per youth class.

Youth classes will be half-price. \$5 each class for youth performance, judging and showmanship. Youth showing in halter classes will pay full class price of \$10.00 per class. Sub-Junior classes FREE.

Minimum age for a handler in any class is 8 years old. Youth 12 years and under are not permitted to show intact adult (24 months and over) male llamas. Youth handler's age is as of their birthday.

ALL llamas MUST have ILR Certificates with the exception of animals (llamas and alpacas) for YOUTH, Performance or Non-Breeders Classes (with vet certificate). If non-breeders are not registered and wish to be in the ALSA Award System and wish to show in halter, they must show in the adult non-breeder halter class. Llamas without ILR certificates at check in time will NOT be permitted to show.

Non-Breeder llamas must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying the animal is a gelding, a vasectomized male, or a spayed or non-reproductive female.

Arrival and Departure:

Arrival may begin after 1:00 on Friday, June 20. Llamas may leave any time after they have completed showing.

Entry Changes: Any entry change (e.g. adding a class or substituting an animal) after arrival at the show will be charged \$10 per change, in addition to any class fees. Substitute animals must qualify to show in the halter or performance class of the original animal. There will be a \$10 fee, to move animals registered in the wrong class, to the correct class after the entry deadline.

Health Requirements:

All llamas & alpacas must be de-wormed within 7 days and free of infectious diseases and its signs. Show management has the right to ask any animal showing signs of ill health or behavioral problems, to leave the premises. The State of Wisconsin requires a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for llamas imported into Wisconsin. Lama Market show does not require health certificates for llamas.

Stalling:

All stalls are in enclosed buildings with concrete floors. **Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding and must clean their stalls prior to their departure.** Exhibitors who do not clean their stalls will not be allowed to show at future Lama Market shows. Common tack areas will be provided. Banners may be displayed at stalls. Display stalls are available, include in your count of stalls wanted. You may bring your own metal panels or rent a stall with panels already installed. Stall size will be 9'x9'. We will allow only 2 animals per stall; 3 per stall if all llamas are under 1 year old. No animals will be allowed to be stalled in trailers.

Rental stalls will be in separate building/s from "bring your own panel" stalls. Special requests that don't fit this cannot be accepted. Thanks for your understanding.

Register early as stalls will be allocated on first come basis. When the barns are full, registration closes and new forms arriving will be returned.

Advertising:

The show program will offer business card ads for \$25.00. (Black and white camera ready is preferred, but not mandatory.) **The card must be enclosed with your entries to be included in the program!** Class sponsorship is \$60.00 per class and includes a full page ad. **(Art work must be provided with entry forms)**

Vendors:

General Information:

Security will be provided.

No animals under 5 months of age may be shown.

Nursing mothers may not be accompanied in the ring by their babies. ALSA recommends not showing nursing mothers.

Llamas may not be moved from one class to another after halter judging has begun, except at Judge's discretion.

Sub-Junior classes are non-ALSA approved. Parent or guardian must be present at ring side for Sub-Junior entrants.

Pack Classes: The llama must be 5 months or older. Pack must have 2 cinches. Llamas over 37 months must carry a pack system with a total weight of 40 lbs. and is required to have removeable panniers. Intermediate and Senior age youth divisions, the llama may carry weight up to 25 pounds if the llama is 37 months of age and older.

Classes may be combined if there are fewer than three entries per class.

Food booths will be available on grounds.

Veterinarian will be on call.

Class 61 Produce of Dam (2 offspring by same dam) If exhibitor is not the dam's owner, written permission from the dam's owner is required and the entry must be made in the owner's name.
